On August 5th, Governor Inslee released guidance for all local health departments regarding reopening K-12 schools (private and public) in the Fall of 2020. Within the guidance, the governor strongly encouraged all local health departments to adopt a metric system for reopening schools.

Within the governor's guidance, it was stated that local charter and private schools may have more flexibility with reopening, based on the size of their facility and lower student body numbers. While still required to meet all mandated safety protocols and cooperate with their local health department, these schools may have an opportunity to adopt the metrics system or develop a more uniquely tailored plan.

It is our desire to fully-reopen for the 2020-2021 school year with on-site instruction. NCS has been invited to attend a meeting on Monday, August 10th with the Thurston County Health Department and other surrounding private schools. Additionally, NCS has requested a follow up meeting with the Thurston County Health Department to specifically discuss our reopening plans.

I ask that our staff, students, and families continue to pray for our campus as we aim to solidify our reopening plans for Fall 2020.
