We have just passed the halfway point of our school year. With the enrollment season upon us, much of our thinking moves towards next year. While there are many exciting opportunities that lie ahead, I'm reminded of a significant teaching of Scripture. While many of the Psalms were written by King David, Psalm 90 is actually attributed to Moses. In verse 12 of this chapter Moses writes, "So teach us to number our days that we may get a heart of wisdom." (ESV) Moses equates the careful consideration of the present with the gaining of wisdom. I think that of all the people who ever lived, Moses may have had more reason than anyone to disregard the present and "live" in the future. Moses was responsible for leading the people of Israel out of Egypt and into the land of promise. They were moving from slavery and poverty to a land that held freedom, wealth, and prosperity. As they wandered through the desert, I can only imagine the temptation for Moses to be completely absentminded in his responsibilities as he thinks about what the Promised Land held for him and God's people. Yet, Moses has the presence of mind to recognize this temptation and record this verse for us that contains such profound truth.

Whether you have a promising future or an uncomfortable present, I would encourage you to heed the wisdom in Moses' words. Number your days. Some people have a literal, physical way of doing this like marking off the days on a calendar each morning. Whatever your method, don't allow the days to slip away. Consider the blessings, challenges, opportunities, and wisdom that can be found in each and every moment, and make full use of the time God has placed in your hands.
