## Math & Science

<u>Bible:</u> - After studying about people in our lives who may be a little harder to be around, we will look at how to 'listen well' in James 1:19-20 and how to 'clothe ourselves in love' found in Colossians 3:12-15.

<u>Science</u>: In Ch. 9, students will do an experiment about the 2nd Law of Motion, by using Pine Wood Derby cars with various weights, as we continue to study forces & motion.

\*Science Fair Project: The next step is to begin recording the steps of your process, showing how you set up the project, and start taking any measurements. REMEMBER to plan around Spring Break, especially if you will be gone, to be able to pace your project.

<u>Math Course 1:</u> Students are working on volume of geometric shapes, ratio problems, and exponents and square roots.

<u>Math Course 2:</u> Students will work on repeating decimals, complementary & supplementary angles, continue using the Distributive Property, and explore Stem-and-Leaf Plots.
