#### Did You Know?

Celebrations like Thanksgiving are not new! In the Old Testament, God's people celebrated the **Feast of Booths (Sukkot)** each fall at harvest time (Leviticus 23:33–43). Families lived in temporary shelters to remember how God provided for Israel during their wilderness journey. It was a week of joy and thanksgiving, as everyone gave thanks for the harvest and for God's faithful care. "The Lord your God will bless you in all your produce and in all the work of your hands, so that you will be altogether joyful" (Deuteronomy 16:15).

This same spirit of contentment and thankfulness is echoed in Paul's words: "I have learned in whatever situation I am to be content. I know how to be brought low, and I know how to abound. In any and every circumstance, I have learned the secret of facing plenty and hunger, abundance and need" (Philippians 4:11–12). Gratitude teaches us to see God's faithfulness in both abundance and in challenge.

#### **Faith & Science Agree**

Even modern research confirms what Scripture has long taught us. A meta-analysis of over 60 studies found that practicing gratitude leads to less anxiety, lower depression, and greater joy. In other words, science is catching up to the truth of Philippians 4:6: "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God." Gratitude isn't just polite—it's powerful.

As we move deeper into this season, may we remember God's provision in the past, celebrate His blessings in the present, and look forward with confidence in His care for the future. Thank you for walking this journey with me, with my family, and with one another. What a gift it is to share in this community of faith and learning.
