## **Vocabulary Words**

**UNFURL**- to cause something that is folded up to open THREATENED to feel that harm is coming your way BURROW a hole or tunnel dug by animals as a place for hiding

**INFLATED**- to enlarge or expand

**IMPRESS**- to make a strong impact on someone or something **TERRITORY**- the region marked and defended by certain animals **SNOUT** -the front part of an animal's head that includes the nose, mouth, and jaws

**UNUSUAL**- uncommon

**INTIMIDATING** -to cause someone or something to become afraid **PREDATOR**- an animal that eats other animals

**VEGETARIAN**- an animal that eats only vegetables, fruits, grains, etc. **BURLY**- having a large, husky body
