I hope this newsletter finds you well as we set out into a new month. Recently my Bible reading brought me to a passage that I found to be a powerful reminder of who our God is.

Thus says the Lord, who makes a way in the sea, a path in the mighty waters, who brings forth chariot and horse, army and warrior; they lie down, they cannot rise, they are extinguished, quenched like a wick: "Remember not the former things, nor consider the things of old. Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert." – **Isaiah 43:16-19 (ESV)**

There are two major encouragements I find in this passage. The first is in the observation of how great and powerful God is. The things that are a source of fear or anxiety for us are no more potent than the flame of a candle to God. No amount of trouble or turmoil can take place without God being in full control. The second encouragement is in the command to not dwell on the "former things." While there are many reasons it is not healthy to spend too much time thinking about the past, the reason found in this passage is that God is at work doing something new. Looking back at what was can cause us to miss what is happening right in front of us. And not only is God at work doing something new, He is doing it in a way that many would think to be impossible. He makes "a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert." He does these things in the very place that no one would expect it to happen.

As we enter a new month and a new semester of school, make this your constant prayer and meditation. Consider how powerful God is; don't dwell on what has already passed; and pay close attention to what God is doing right now. You just might witness something miraculous.
