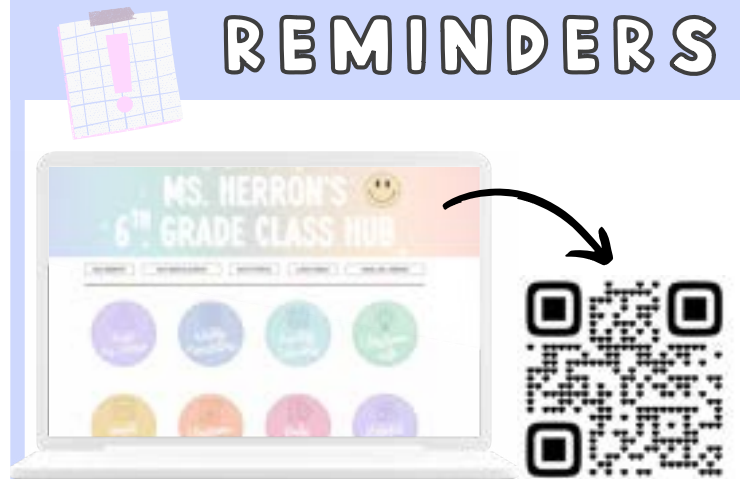
BJU Ancient Civilizations | Unit 4: Ancient Greece
