



SUGGESTED SEQUENCE CONCURRENT CREDIT & ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP)

NCHS students can earn college credit while also earning high school credit in the classroom at Northwest Christian High School. This is a great opportunity for students to get a start on earning college credit prior to graduating high school or enrolling in a college. The information below provides the college level courses that are offered and a suggested sequence for a student to maximize the benefits of our Concurrent Credit & AP program. Please note that there is flexibility in the course sequence and some courses are not offered every year.
